Job Description:

As the Graphic Designer & Illustrator, the CSJ participant will be engaged, with a staff, in the design elements and aspects of the development of an education website – **Living History Hope & Peace**. It will include responsibilities to

- Work with project team to determine the nature and content of illustrations
- Determine the medium best suited to produce the desired visual effect and the most appropriate vehicle for communication
- Develop the graphic elements that meet objectives
- Prepare sketches, layouts and graphic elements of the subjects to be rendered using multimedia software and layout and design software
- Develop and produce realistic or representational sketches and final illustrations using appropriate design software
- Assist in developing storyboards for website productions such as multimedia, interactive and digital products
- Produce 2-D and 3-D animated drawings or computer illustrations
- Enhance existing illustrations and images such as photos

Applicant Assets: Very good at research; adaptable and flexible in team work; receives feedback as part of learning; demonstrates initiative, creativity and critical thinking; excellent problem-solving skills; competent in digital design and graphic content creation skills to meet user experience and user flow
